On April 2-3, 2021 H. S. Skovoroda Kharkiv National Pedagogical University is holding International Scientific Conference

**«Arguments of Modern Philology: "Lack "and" Desire "in the Text».**

**The purpose of the conference is** to discuss associations of "lack" and "desire" in the text, which emphasize the "unconscious concept" while revealing it in language and literature at lexical, grammatical, syntactic levels with reference to the "mirror stage" in the ideas and artistic means conditioned by the "word".

On the basis of literary and linguistic interpretation, it is suggested to pay attention to the "psychoanalytic" perception of the "conscious" and "unconscious" text, to identify "ephemerality", "conditionality" and "subjectivity". It will establish the processes of "communication": open, complicated or impossible in language, literature, cinema, art, psychology, sociology, pedagogy, methods of language and literature teaching.

**Main topics:**

- Psychological symptoms and phases, dominance or veiling of the "unconscious" in the perspective of interpretation of artistic and non-artistic texts.
- Unconscious motives, feelings and emotions. Open / absent / elusive communication. Implementation of conflicts in language and literature.

- Reflection and general understanding the categories of the "unconscious" in language and literature teaching; verbal and nonverbal communication in language and literature teaching.
- "Mental" in the historical context at the level of artistic and non-artistic texts.
- "Lack" and "desire" in the text.

**Working languages:** Ukrainian, English, Polish, Russian, Chinese.

## Requirements for the abstract

(\* the file is named after the author's Latin name, such as: Ivanenko\_tezy).

1. Abstracts are five full pages (approximately 7500 characters or about 1250 words), which include a summary in English of 150-200 words, keywords 7-10, bibliography of 5 positions (according to the requirements of Web of Science). If the participants of the conference have uncertainty in the style of the English version, they should ask conference organizers for review. Proceedings of the conference will be published on the Internet in free electronic access.

2. Technical requirements:

- fields to the left, top, bottom 2,5 cm, to the right 1 cm;
- paragraph indent 1,25 cm;
- Times New Roman font;
- 14 font sizes;
- line spacing 1,5;
- paragraph spacing 0 pt;
- if the text has names, then an unbreakable space is made between the first and last name or first name and the initials (simultaneously pressing the Ctrl Shift space)
- the same type of quotation marks are used throughout the text «»;
- clearly differentiate the dash (–) and the hyphen (-);
- illustrative material is in italics;
- elements of the text that, according to the author's abstract, need to be highlighted, are marked in bold italics.

3. The order of materials placement:

- at the beginning of the abstract, its title is placed (typed in capital letters, in bold type, with the equation in the center of the page);
- the next line indicates the surname, the author's initials, in brackets the city (this information is printed with the equation on the page center without a bold selection; in capital letters only the first letter of the last name, initials and the first letter of the city name);
- the main abstract text, which is executed with strict observance of the technical requirements, is placed (see paragraph 2);
- if the abstract contains footnotes, they are placed in a block without automatic references after the main abstract text;
- if the abstract contains bibliographic references, they are placed after the footnotes (if any) or the main abstract text (if no footnote is available) and are executed according to 6th APA Style Manual.
